- 1) Welcome to new members
- 2) Vote and adopt last meeting minutes  
Unanimous, last meeting minutes adopted.
- 3) Any comments on the website or forum?

- 4) Who wants Club T-Shirts? Order to be placed at the end of the meeting.

- 5) Any comments or suggestions regarding Hobbyworld parts inventory?

- 1) Do we want to use spec tires again next season?

- 3) Any rule changes?

#### Carpet Season

- 1) Need people to look into permanent facilities.

Don Buck still looking, but so far has not found much.  
Chad mentioned all vendors want to be paid market price, so that is not viable.  
Decision: To keep using Cardinal Leger for now.
- 2) Need to paint track borders  
Kevin will check schedule and post on forum a time for all to help out. Check forum.
- 3) Need to wash road rails  
Will complete at same time as painting.
- 4) Rubber tires for Novice?  
Issue voted on majority decided: Tires will be open (can run either foam or rubber)
- 5) Any other rule changes?
